First bug report bear with me.			
Issue does not occur in 0.9.1 - Windows 8.1 x64 Issue occurs in 0.10 - Windows 8.1 x64			
When attempting to type in /setkey I receive the following error:

Expected result is that it would auth. with the channel or with the user.			
This can be fixed by copying a 0.9.1 install on top of 10 replacing all files (obviously). I also noticed in 0.10 C:\Program Files (x86)\Quassel\plugins\crypto is missing.
