<b>Description</b>			
<p>If using this backlog requester, it can happen that there are messages missing right after the "red line". I suspect this happens if the message limit is exceeded. In this case, only \$limit messages are fetched (that is to be expected and ok), but in addition, also older (read) messages are fetched. This leads to a gap that is easily missed (only if you happen to check the timestamps, you'll notice that you missed messages).</p> <p>So if the limit is exceeded, we shouldn't fetch read messages, such that the user notices that he hasn't reached the red line yet.</p>
