quassel is changing it's away-status every 5 minutes to available and back to away, if the user is not connected to the core.			
can be seen in queries from other clients, here is a log from colloquy:

There is no timer in Quassel that triggers an away (or unaway).

What you see here is just simply the behavior of Colloquy. On networks not supporting WATCH Colloquy checks every 5 minutes via ISON if the query partner is online.

2009-06-22 17:25:39 <m4yer> is now available.  
this message is the result of the RPL\_IISON (note: it doesn't read "is no longer away").

2009-06-22 17:25:39 <m4yer> is marked as away.  
Colloquy also checks the status of the query partner regularly via WHOIS. This message is the result of the WHOIS reply.

You can easily confirm this behavior by opening Colloquy's "Console" to check the raw irc messages going in and out.
